1. Purpose

In order to protect the life, health, and integrity of all individuals, and in accordance with the provisions of **Supreme Decree N° 44** of the Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare, which approves the **“New Regulations on Preventive Management of Occupational Risks for a safe and healthy work environment”**.

2. Scope

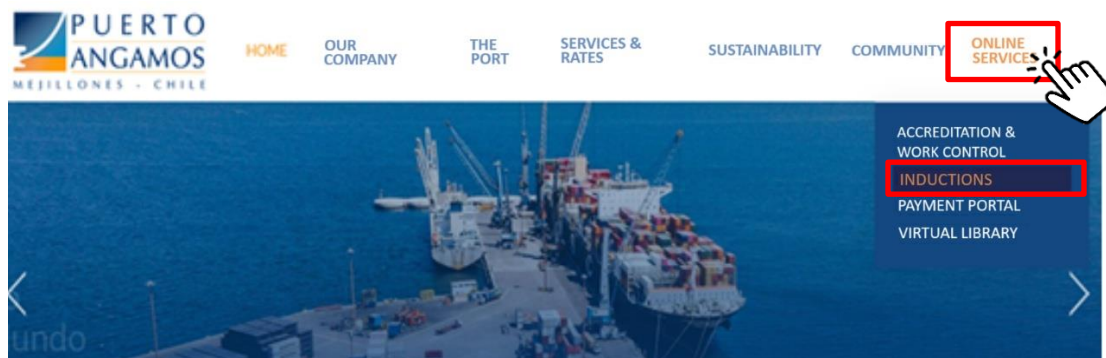
These instructions have been prepared as part of the preventive measures implemented by Puerto Angamos and are available to all workers, visitors, suppliers, among others who, with prior authorization and justification, must enter the facilities. For this purpose, an online induction and knowledge test has been made available.

To ensure compliance with safety and operational protocols, an online induction and knowledge assessment process has been made available on the Puerto Angamos website, which must be completed prior to entry.

3. Initial Online Safety Induction

3.1 Access to online induction:

1. Go to www.puertoangamos.cl
2. Go to the **Online Services** tab
3. Select **Inductions**



4. You can also access the link directly at www.puertoangamos.cl/inducciones/
5. The download files will be displayed immediately



3.2 Viewing and downloading the following files:

1. **F-SIG-059 Letter of responsibility in Spanish (ESP):** This file is personal, so each employee or visitor must sign it individually.
2. **F-SIG-059 Letter of responsibility in English (ENG):** This file is personal, so each employee or visitor must sign it individually.

When clicking on each download file (PDF document), it will open in a new browser tab, from which you can proceed to download it.

3.3 Conducting the online induction

1. Once you have entered the “Inductions” tab, click on the **“PUERTO ANGAMOS SAFETY INDUCTION”** box. A window will then pop up with instructions on how to register on the platform using your RUT or other documents (passport).
2. In addition to your RUT or passport, the platform will request the following information: Full name (2 first names and 2 last names), email address, and company name.
3. This information is essential for the subsequent issuance of the **certificate of approval**, which is a necessary requirement to enable access and register in the system.

PUERTO ANGAMOS SAFETY INDUCTION

- A window will then pop up allowing you to start viewing the induction video. In the **“Test to be submitted”** tab, click on the **“Submit”** button.

- The introductory video will immediately begin playing. Please watch it carefully so that you can answer the knowledge test correctly. When it is finished, press **“Next.”**
The video is available with Spanish subtitles and sign language, as well as English subtitles.



3.4 Knowledge Test

- Once you have finished watching the induction video, press "**Next**" to display the knowledge test, which consists of 10 single-choice questions. The questions will be different for each person who enters the induction.
Make sure you have answered all 10 questions and when you have finished, press "**Save**."

- Once you have submitted your answers by clicking the "Save" button, the system will display your test results, where you can review your final status (Pass or Fail) and the correct and incorrect answers.
The knowledge test is passed with a minimum of 70% correct answers (7 out of 10 correct).

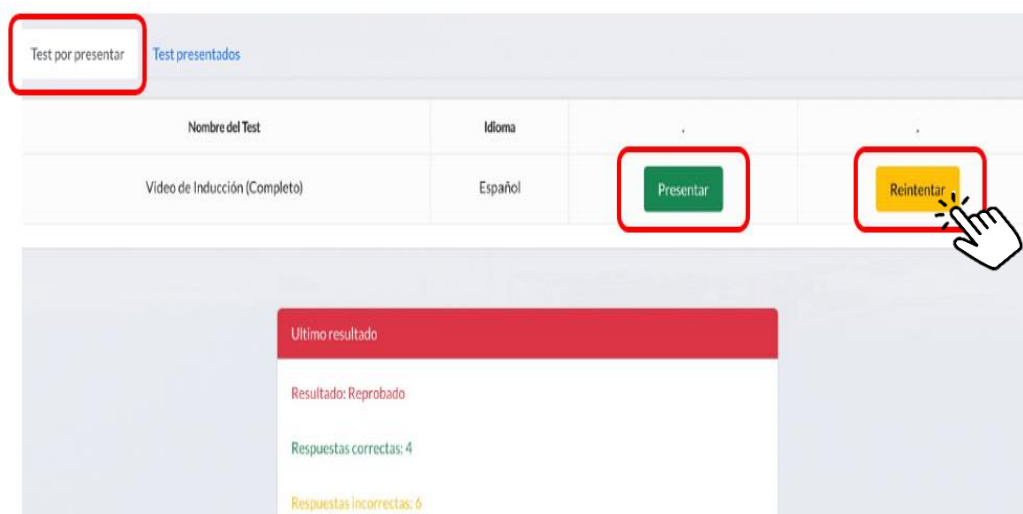

3.6 Failed Tests:

If you fail, the system will give you the option to retry. To do so, you will have to repeat the whole process, which includes watching the induction videos again. To do so, click on the **"Test to be submitted"** tab and then click on **"Retry"**.

To watch the video again, click on **"Submit"**.

Important: The induction video graphically and thoroughly explains the preventive measures within port facilities. Therefore, paying attention to its instructions, which are solely intended to protect the life, health, and integrity of individuals, will enable passing this simple knowledge test without inconveniences.

Remember to watch/listen to the video in a controlled environment that will allow paying attention to its content.

3.7 Online Induction Validation:

To make the online induction effective, the user company must send the indicated records, **scanned in PDF format**, to the following e-mail address: induccionesangamos@puertoangamos.cl (Angamos inductions) at least 24 hours in advance:

1. **F-SIG-059 (ESP):** Letter of responsibility in Spanish
2. **F-SIG-059 (ENG):** Letter of responsibility in English
3. **Test approval Certificate:** File automatically generated by the platform when the induction is passed

Additionally, all companies that perform online induction must send, in the same email as the induction backups, the following data:

- i. Company name (business name and trade name)
- ii. Company tax ID number
- iii. Company address
- iv. Contact telephone number
- v. Reason for visit or job description
- vi. Length of stay inside the facilities
- vii. Name of internal contact at Puerto (this point does not apply to transport companies)

Important: Internal contact at TGN must be included in the email recipient field. This contact will be responsible for validating the corresponding access.

In the case of **contractors** and **subcontractors**, induction records must be uploaded via Workmate, the accreditation and work control platform.

3.8 Validity of the online induction system

All online inductions will be valid for a period of **12 months (one year)**. However, any modification to the preventive measures may consider a shorter period of validity than indicated, which will be duly notified through the official channels of the website www.puertoangamos.cl or official communications via e-mail.

The response time for the induction system enablement is within 24 hours after receiving the induction records and induction approval certificates online via e-mail.

The knowledge test is performed only the first time, renewals (induction extension) must be requested directly to Security in the inductions box (induccionesangamos@puertoangamos.cl), by sending the registration form F-SIG-059 Letter of Responsibility, duly signed.

4. Access to the facilities

4.1 Código ISPS

Puerto Angamos is certified under the International Ship and Port Security (ISPS) Code, known in Spanish as the Código Internacional para la Protección de los Buques y de las Instalaciones Portuarias (PBIP). For this reason, **identification is mandatory for all persons entering the port as pedestrians or drivers, including public officials and inspectors** (IMO Resolution N° 1156).

4.2 Pedestrian access

1. All pedestrians entering the premises **must carry a valid identity card or passport**, Visitors must present themselves at the main entrance to verify that their entry pass and authorization (induction) are up to date in order to enter.
2. Once access has been validated, the worker or visitor must enter through the turnstiles, which are activated with their identity card. If using a passport, a security guard will provide instructions on how to activate the turnstile.

3. Pedestrians may only walk on authorized and marked pedestrian paths. In addition, to enter operational areas, they must have authorization and use all personal protective equipment required for transit and in accordance with the site.
4. No distractions while walking, such as electronic devices or headphones.

4.3 Vehicle access

1. All drivers must carry their **identity card and valid driver's license**, in accordance with legal regulations.
2. Authorized vehicles must stop at the “Stop” sign marked on the floor and proceed to the designated vehicle lane. They must also follow the instructions given by security guards at the entrance lanes.
3. Lanes No. 1 and No. 3 are open for **authorized small vehicles** to enter; however, exit will be via Lanes No. 3 or No. 5.

Important: Upon entry, if there are passengers in the vehicle, they must exit at the main entrance and enter through the turnstiles. Only the driver registers at the Totem.

When exiting, however, all occupants of the vehicle must remain inside (it is prohibited to get out), where only the driver registers their exit at the Totem and the exit of the passengers is registered by the security guard who will be waiting at the side of the exit lane.

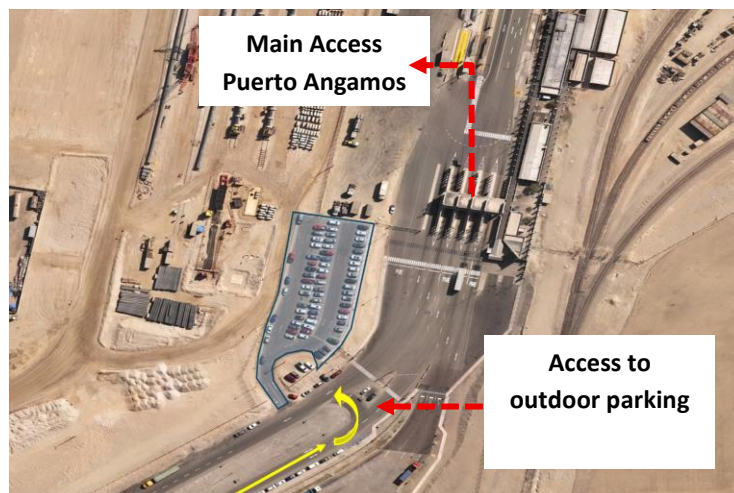
4. For the purpose of Carrier entry, the vehicle lane will be assigned according to the site.

5. The vehicle lanes will have signs indicating which lane is open for entry or exit, as applicable:
 - Green: Track enabled
 - Red: Track not enabled (not operational)

6. Access for private vehicles is restricted, therefore any exceptional entry must be authorized by Management. Such private vehicles must be parked in the outdoor parking lots located next to the main entrance.

To access the Project Yard or Secondary Area, this must use **Gate No. 8**. Both carriers and workers or visitors must be duly authorized via email and carry their identity card. Drivers must also carry their valid driver's license at all times, which must be appropriate for the vehicle they are driving. Transport companies, in addition to being authorized with a list, must submit a waybill at Gate No. 8.

7. Visitors who are duly authorized to enter with a vehicle may use the parking area of the Administration Building within the facilities.

8. The parking spaces at the Operations Building located in the maritime area are for the exclusive use of institutional vehicles belonging to internal staff of Puerto Angamos and Ultraport.

4.4 Driver requirements:

1. Carry a valid identity card (this requirement also applies to passengers in the vehicle)
2. Carry a valid driver's license

4.5 Vehicle requirements:

All vehicles transporting personnel entering the facilities shall:

- Carry a properly-working amber flashing or strobe light
- Access with lights on at all times, without exception
- Observe a maximum speed of **25 km/h**, which may be lower depending on the operational area, environmental conditions, and specific signage in each sector

5. 5. Obligations and Emergency Numbers

5.1 Use of basic Personal Protective Equipment:



Important:

The items listed above are the basic requirements for working in port facilities, which includes limbs fully covered. Additionally, specific personal protective equipment may be used depending on the nature of each operation, such as safety harnesses, hearing protection, respiratory protection, specialized work clothing, among others.

5.2 Other Obligations:

1. The use of cell phones or distracting items in operational areas is prohibited
2. Respect the prohibition on entering restricted areas
3. Pedestrian paths will only be allowed in areas designated for that purpose
4. All waste must be disposed of in the containers provided and marked for this purpose

CARTA DE RESPONSABILIDAD INDUCCIÓN DE SEGURIDAD E INGRESO A PUERTO ANGAMOS

Principales Instrucciones:

- Cumplir a cabalidad con las medidas preventivas establecidas en los estándares de riesgos críticos:
 - Estándares de Prevención 4 A+C:** 1) Altura, 2) Atropello, 3) Aplastamiento, 4) Atrapamiento y 5) Contacto con energías, incluyendo en este último la prohibición de transitar en las cercanías o exponerse a las bitas con espías amarradas (liberación de gran energía al romperse la espía / riesgo de golpe a las personas).
 - Estándares de Prevención +5C:** 1) Caída de personas al mar, 2) Caída de objetos desde altura, 3) Trabajos en Caliente, 4) Espacios confinados y atmósferas peligrosas y 5) Contacto con sustancias peligrosas.
- Cumplir con las reglas cardinales (Caminos para llegar a casa) establecidas por la Compañía.
- Está estrictamente prohibido ejecutar labores bajo la influencia o efectos del alcohol, drogas o estupefacientes; así como tampoco se podrá ingresar o comercializar estas sustancias al interior de nuestras instalaciones.
- Uso correcto y obligatorio de los Elementos de Protección Personal (EPP) en zonas operativas o aquellas zonas donde se indique: Casco de seguridad, anteojos de seguridad, chaleco reflectante, calzado de seguridad, guantes de seguridad para manipular herramientas u objetos, bloqueador solar F-50 y vestimenta adecuada que proteja y cubra la totalidad de sus brazos y piernas. Recuerde que cada área y actividad tiene requerimientos específicos de uso de EPP, dependiendo de la labor que se realice.
- No ingresar a zonas restringidas o distintas a las autorizadas en su ingreso, salvo en el caso particular de las autoridades fiscalizadoras del Estado, cuyo ingreso a las áreas de acceso restringido deberá ser asistido por personal responsable de Puerto Angamos por motivos de seguridad, tomando todas las medidas preventivas necesarias.
- Avisar al Supervisor que lo acompañe o personal interno de la compañía que se encuentre más cercano para que informen, a quien corresponda, de cualquier desviación que detecte durante su estadía en las instalaciones.
- Ante la ocurrencia de cualquier emergencia, mantener la calma y seguir las instrucciones que se indiquen, y en particular, de quien tenga la responsabilidad en esos momentos. En las instalaciones se encuentran planos de evacuación con las rutas por las cuales debe dirigirse.
- Dirigirse a zona de seguridad "PEE" (Punto de Encuentro de Emergencia) en caso de sismo, tsunami, incendio u otra emergencia que amerite evacuación. Si el sismo no le permite mantenerse en pie, debe evacuar. **Antes, debe esperar a que éste cese y luego evaluar las condiciones del entorno y de la ruta.**
Importante: Si el sismo no le permite mantenerse en pie, no debe esperar una señal de alarma sonora u otro aviso para iniciar la evacuación.
- Prohibido fumar, ejecutar trabajos en caliente o con proyección de partículas incandescentes cuando se encuentren almacenadas o se estén manipulando sustancias o mercancías peligrosas inflamables, combustibles, explosivos o con cualquier otra categoría de peligrosidad incompatibles con fuentes de calor.
- La velocidad máxima de circulación es de 25 km/h, la que podrá ser inferior dependiendo de la zona operativa. El conductor siempre debe portar su licencia de conducir vigente y acorde al vehículo que conduce.
- Todos los ocupantes del vehículo deben utilizar cinturón de seguridad.
- Respete toda la normativa y señalización de tránsito (legal e interna) y de seguridad de la compañía.
- Los equipos y maquinarias portuarias tienen preferencia por sobre los vehículos; éstos (maquinarias y vehículos), a su vez, tienen preferencia de paso por sobre los peatones. Lo anterior, para resguardar la integridad de las personas.

Toma conocimiento y me comprometo a cumplir fielmente todas las disposiciones y normativas de ingreso, seguridad y prevención de riesgos de Puerto Angamos.

- Al transitar (caminar) o conducir está estrictamente prohibido utilizar elementos de distracción como audífonos, celulares u otros artefactos electrónicos que alteren la concentración de las personas respecto al entorno.
- Está estrictamente prohibido realizar labores de mantenimiento y limpieza de equipos, o cualquier actividad que involucre generación de residuos industriales y peligrosos en nuestras instalaciones. A su vez, los camiones (tracto y rampla) y sus conductores deben estar debidamente registrados en la web de agendamiento de Puerto Angamos.
- Prohibido contaminar, dañar o afectar el medio ambiente. Cumplir con la segregación de residuos establecida. Al detectar una oportunidad de mejora, una desviación o afectación al medio ambiente, dar aviso inmediato a la línea de supervisión para activar los protocolos ambientales.
- Puerto Angamos, se encuentra certificada bajo el código internacional ISPS (International Ship and Port Security), en español, Código Internacional para la Protección de los Buques y de las Instalaciones Portuarias (PBIP). Es por ello que la identificación es obligatoria (cédula identidad vigente o pasaporte en caso de visitas extranjeras).

En consecuencia, bajo mi nombre y firma, declaro lo siguiente:
Al ingresar voluntariamente a las instalaciones de Puerto Angamos, he sido informado e instruido de los peligros y riesgos a los que estaré expuesto y sus medidas preventivas y de control mediante la Inducción Inicial de Seguridad y Código ISPS, así por ello que manifiesto que he comprendido las principales instrucciones de seguridad.
